2021 Charleston Speedway Limited Late Models Rules

- 1. Any Late Model Chassis is acceptable.
- 2. Any Late Model Body is acceptable. Body rules will follow DIRTcar Pro Modified body rules.
- 3. Only Late Model type tires will be allowed.
- 4. Any brand or compound Late Model type tire is acceptable.
- 5. Minimum car weight with driver at the end of the race is 2400 lbs.
- 6. Maximum engine rpm is 6500rpm. Must have easy access to inspect ignition box for rpm. "Chip" type or "Dial" type rev limiting boxes will be allowed.
- 7. Engine rules:
 - a. Maximum 360c.i.
 - b. OEM steel block ONLY.
 - c. NO stroker engines allowed.
 - d. NO dry sump oiling systems allowed.
 - e. Must use 23 degree heads steel or aluminum.
 - f. Only one 4bbl Carburetor allowed.
 - g. Super Bowl Carburetors will NOT be allowed on ANY engine.
 - h. Engine CAN be the 604 UMP sealed engine. If it is a sealed engine, it MUST REMAIN SEALED and UNALTERED.
- 8. Fuel can be pump gas, E85 or racing fuel, NO alcohol(alky).
- Shocks can be any steel or aluminum gas or twin tube(oil) shock. Adjustable and/or rebuild able shocks are allowed. NO remote canister shocks.
- 10. Carbon fiber drive shafts are allowed.

WINGS are optional. The following rules apply cars using wings.

- 1. Drivers side wing maximum 24" X 60", minimum 22" X 55".
- 2. Passenger side wing maximum 12" X 40", minimum 10" X 36".
- 3. Nose wings maximum 6" X 30".
- 4. ALL wings MUST be clear "Lexan" only.
- 5. Wings can have some sponsor decals on them, but can not be covered in any way that will obstruct the drivers view from in the drivers seat.
